### Probate Fees

Per Probate Codes §10800 and §10810, a Professional Fiduciary's Probate fees are typically calculated as a percentage of the total estate value, with a sliding scale that decreases as the estate value increases. ### Other Information

- The fee for managing the sale of real property is 1% of the sales price. This flat fee covers all necessary fiduciary work involved in the transaction.
- Billing occurs in 1/10th of an hour increments. Travel time is billed one-way at standard hourly rates.
- Fees are billed and paid monthly, excepting court-mandated fee structures (such as Probate).
